Most of this is already being done, but still a good suggestion. The majority of the board members think it might be better to leave things the way they are. (Different people for different tasks) Sherrie will head the "Longest Day" event again. Since this is on a Sunday, (participation may be a problem), she would like to move it to Monday. She will check with ACBL to see if that's okay. Maintenance: Wayne says that the cabinets are ordered and will be put in during the National tournament. The coffee system will be over a drainage system. Wayne will speak to Jani-King about the problem with leaky garbage bags. They will wash the dishes after the tournaments for an extra \$25. The timer screen will be moved on top of the coffee cabinet after the cabinet is installed. Suggestion box: The BOD voted not to start an Ambassador program. No decision at this time to implement an increase in pay for the directors for the I/N sectional tournaments. Larry will find out how much Baton Rouge pays their 299er directors.
