

# **Bridge Club Etiquette**

#### In actions and words...

- Arrive early so the director can set up the game and start on time.
- Turn off your cell phone/mute/ vibrate settings only. Do not check your messages during the game to see what you have missed! (Exception on urgent call expected-inform director.)
- Greet your opponents when they come to the table-BRIEFLY. This is not an opportunity to hear about Harry's summer vacation or the latest news on the grandchildren.
- For declarer and dummy: Dummy is encouraged to say "good luck, Partner" when laying down the dummy hand. Declarer is expected to say "Thank you, Partner" after seeing the dummy (without grimacing if the dummy isn't looking too promising!)
- Criticizing your partner's bidding or play or the opponents' play is considered a Zero Tolerance infraction. This also applies to gloating about the results of a hand.
- Complimenting an opponent's play of a difficult hand when warranted is always appreciated.
- Be respectful of the director AT ALL TIMES. If the director is called to the table, do not argue.
   Control your temper. These are Zero Tolerance infractions. If you disagree with a director's call, you may report it to the Club Manager or President for additional review.
- Giving bridge advice to an opponent on bidding or play should not be done unless requested or
  without asking the player if he/she would like your opinion regarding what he/she might have
  done differently.
- Discussion of the hand(s) should only be done at the conclusion of the round, <u>if time permits</u>, and all conversation should be conducted in a low voice. Bridge is a timed event. Slow play impacts other players.
- E/W should not ask E/W players at the next table to vacate their positions before the round has been called, particularly if they are moving to a table that is still playing.
- Keep chairs pushed in to keep walkways free.
- After the game, pick up the boards, bridgemate and guide card and return them to the proper locations. The director should not have to pick up after the players!
- Be mindful of any cups, wrappers, trash, etc. Be sure to dispose of your trash properly as a courtesy to other players-before, during and after the game!
